1. Summary

In the frame of MEDA GO TO EUROPE project Slovenian project partner University of Primorska, Science and Research Centre of Koper (UP ZRS) as leader of WP4 was responsible for the activity of Match-making and Consortium Building. Within this activity UP ZRS identified a number of researchers from academia and industry, particularly in Mediterranean Countries, who somehow successfully joined project consortiums for submission of joint project proposals following calls in Cooperation Programme - priority Food, Agriculture, Fisheries and Biotechnology (KBBE).

During 3-year period more than 115 match-making attempts were performed either within Brokerage Events or via other channels (e-mails, etc.) from which 45 were successful and resulted in joint submission of (approx.) 28 project proposals. In the table below you can see exhaustive summary information of the successful match-making attempts and consortium building services (offered to Mediterranean researchers from RTOs and SMEs either by Mediterranean MEDA GO TO EUROPE project partners or by European MEDA GO TO EUROPE project partners) which resulted in successful submission of project proposal.
